When is the application deadline for PSEO?

June 1st for the Fall semester
December 1st for Winter semester
Deadlines are FIRM.

Can males take PSEO classes?

Yes, both males and females are welcome to apply to our St. Kate's PSEO program.

What are the admissions requirements for the PSEO program?

Students enrolling in this program are generally in the upper 25% of their high school class and have followed a rigorous college preparatory course of study. Students are expected to have earned no lower than a B in their high school coursework.

What is the process for admission?

New students need to apply by submitting the following:

1. PSEO application (which asks for biographical info),
2. The three-part state form (to be filled out by the student, parent and the high school),
3. Official high school transcript
4. Counselor recommendation.

If the student is **currently taking PSEO classes, here at St. Kate's**, s/he needs to submit **just the application and three-part state form**. Acceptance is **contingent on the grade** s/he receives in the class in which currently enrolled.

Once I've applied to your PSEO program, how will I know that I'm accepted?

PSEO applications will be reviewed after the application deadline for that semester. You will receive a letter of acceptance.

Can I enroll full-time, as a PSEO student?

No. Students are limited to two classes per academic year. Students can choose to take one class each semester or two classes for one semester only.

May I be enrolled in classes at another institution, while I am enrolled at St. Kate's?

Yes.

Will I be able to take a math class such as Calculus or a language class?

Yes. You will be required to take a placement test to determine which math or language courses are available for you to take. In some cases, you may also use your ACT math subscore to qualify for certain math courses.

Do I need to submit a test score, such as the ACT or SAT, with my application?

No. We will evaluate you based on your counselor recommendation and your transcripts.

I'm currently enrolled at St. Kate's through the PSEO program; do I need to re-apply for the next semester?

Yes, you are responsible for resubmitting your materials no later than the application deadline for that semester

How will I know which classes to take?

Discuss your schedule with your guidance counselor to determine which classes you are required to complete to be eligible for graduation. Some students use PSEO to fulfill graduation requirements, others use PSEO to gain college credit and some students use PSEO to take fun, college-level electives.

THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT YOU WILL BE ABLE TO TAKE A SPECIFIC COURSE TO FULFILL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS OR BE ABLE TO ENROLL IN AN EVENING CLASS.

PSEO students register after most St. Kate's students have already completed their schedules. Accepted PSEO students will be sent a list of available courses the day before registration. Until then, all students may access campus Course Schedules on the [Registrar's website](#).

Be sure to indicate "Fall" or "Winter" semester. You can view a course description, seat availability, and prerequisites by clicking on the title of the course.

The class that I want to take is full or has a prerequisite listed. Is it still possible to register for that class?

It is the student's responsibility to contact the department or professor in order to obtain special permission to register for a class that is already full prior to registration. In general, once a course is full, it is full, and prerequisites are required in order to have the knowledge base to be successful in that course.

I am a past PSEO student and I need an official copy of my transcript. Where do I go?

All current and past students enrolled at St. Kate's must contact the Office of the Registrar in order to request an official transcript.
