Art Full Text via WilsonWeb covers more than 400 leading art publications from around the world, including journals and museum bulletins; the full text from 100 publications is included. It covers topics such as art history, archaeology, architecture, crafts, film, folk art, graphic arts, industrial design, interior design, landscape architecture, museology, painting, photography, sculpture, and textiles. It also indexes reproductions of works of art that appear anywhere in any of the indexed publications.

Coverage: Citations from 1984 to the present; Full text coverage from 1997 to the present.

How to access Art Index

- Go to the Libraries' homepage:

- With your cursor on **Find Articles**, slide over and select **Databases and Indexes**.

Off-campus users will need to enter their **KateWay** or **CSC network login** to access the databases. Contact the HelpDesk (651-690-6402) for assistance with this login.

You can:

- Search by title: Select **A** from the alphabetic list of databases and find **Art Index**. Click on the link for **Art Full Text**.
- **Browse databases by subject** using the drop-down menu to select the subject **Art**, then click on the link for **Art Full Text**.

Searching in Art Full Text

The default is an Advanced Search.

- Enter your search term(s) in the box(es). The search engine automatically truncates your terms (that is, will look for all endings of the words in any order). For phrase searching or to avoid truncations, use quotation marks around your term(s).
- Use the drop-down menus to select where you wish your search terms to appear (All-Smart Search, Keyword, Title, etc.). Unless you are searching for a specific article or author, you can leave the default option *All-Smart Search*.
- Connect your terms by selecting **AND**, **OR**, or **NOT** from the dropdown menus.
- Apply any limits, such as sorting, date limits, document type or format.
- Click on the **Start** button.

Navigating Art Full Text

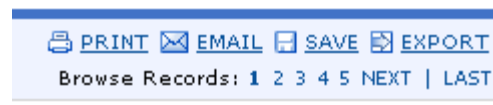
The search menu at the top will allow you to do a basic or advanced search, browse, and other tasks.

Links and tabs at the top left allow you to navigate your results. The top links allow you to revise your search or create an alert to let you know when new items matching this search are added to the database.



The tabs allow you to review categories of results (all results, full text, full text in PDF, and peer reviewed journals) with a single click. You can manage your marked records through the links below the results tabs.

Use the navigation links in the top and bottom right corners to view more pages of results, switch back and forth between brief and full views, and perform a new search.



Refining the Search

Use the **Content Discovery Keys** in the left column of the results page to refine your search. You can **narrow** your search by author, subject, or document type.

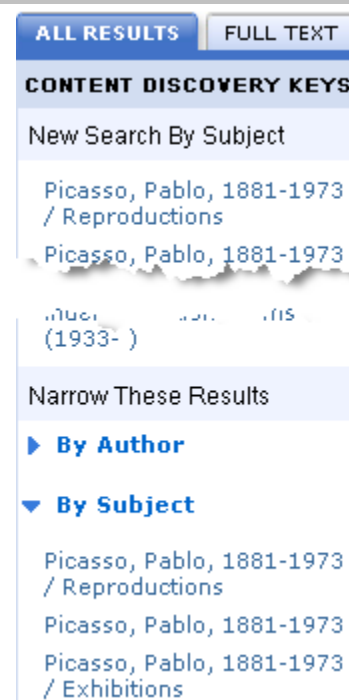
Limit or expand your search by using the options on the Advanced Search page.
