

Finding Newspaper Articles

Most newspapers have websites that provide current articles and news, but may require you to pay for older articles. Instead, use the St. Kate's databases for free to search for and access full-text newspaper articles from the *Star Tribune*, the *Pioneer Press*, the *New York Times*, and many others:

- **ProQuest Newspapers**
- **ProQuest Historical Newspapers The New York Times**
- **St. Paul Pioneer Press via NewsBank**

Access these and other news sources:

- Begin at the Library's homepage (library.stkate.edu)
- Go to **Find** Articles and click on **Databases and Indexes**
- Use the Subject drop-down menu and find **News and Current Events** (or go directly to: library.stkate.edu/connect/newspaper.html)
- Databases for newspaper articles are listed. Click on the database you wish to search.
- You can also find your database by going to the **Databases and Indexes** page and using the alphabetical list.

ProQuest Newspapers

(*New York Times*, *Wall Street Journal*, *Star Tribune*, and other national newspapers)

- Begin at the library's homepage: <http://library.stkate.edu>
- Go to **Find Articles** and click on **Databases and Indexes**.
- Click on **ProQuest Newspapers** from the list of **CSC Favorites**
- You begin at the Basic Search screen. You can search all papers in the database here or select the **Publications** tab to select a particular newspaper.

ProQuest Historical Newspapers

(*New York Times*, 1851-two years ago)

- Begin at the library's homepage: <http://library.stkate.edu>
- Go to **Find Articles** and click on **Databases and Indexes**.
- Click on **ProQuest Newspapers** from the list of **CSC Favorites** (or using the alphabetical list, **Browse databases by title** and go to **ProQuest**)
- Select **News – The Historical New York Times** from the **Database** drop down menu.
- A new page will load: enter your search in the boxes.

Lexis-Nexis Academic

(Various coverage of major newspapers such as the *New York Times*, *Minneapolis Star Tribune*, *Los Angeles Times*, and more)

- Begin at the library's homepage: <http://library.stkate.edu>
- Go to **Find Articles** and click on **Databases and Indexes**.
- Using the alphabetical list, **Browse databases by title** and go to **Lexis-Nexis** (OR click on the link in the list of **CSC Favorites**)
- Click on **Lexis-Nexis Academic**.
- Select the **News** tab at the top of the screen to begin your search.



St. Paul Pioneer Press via NewsBank

(1988 to the present)

- Begin at the library's homepage: <http://library.stkate.edu>
- Go to **Find Articles** and click on **Databases and Indexes**.
- Using the alphabetical list, **Browse databases by title** and go to Saint Paul Pioneer Press
- Click on the link **St. Paul Pioneer Press via NewsBank**.
- Select the link for **St. Paul Pioneer Press** on the right side of the screen.
- Read recent editions by selecting the link for the issue you want to read.
- Search at the top using keywords and article titles, or select a particular date or time period.

Hints and Help

- The easiest way to find an article to which you already have a citation is to **type the exact title in "quotes"** in the search box. You can also use the dates to **browse** to the correct date.
- For best printing, use the **print option** provided in the database.
- Check to see if CSC has access to a newspaper not listed here by using the **Periodical Cat** (library.stkate.edu/per_list/index.html) and enter the newspaper's title in the search box.
